

Air Nation has been designed for you to have as much fun as possible. But you MUST observe this safety advice and rules at all times:

The Inflatable has TWO emergency fire exits situated at the rear of the Inflatable. In the event of an emergency please leave the Inflatable either via the entrance to the inflatable or via the emergency exits at the rear, whichever is closest. To leave via the emergency exit on the Inflatable, please remove the Velcro and exit through the emergency exit hatch and turn to the right. Proceed to exit the building through the nearest fire door.

- Every person must have completed a waiver form prior to entering the inflatable.
- Only enter the inflatable when instructed to do so by a member of staff.
- DO NOT enter the inflatable if you are pregnant and / or are suffering from any injuries or health conditions.
- DO NOT enter the inflatable if you suffer from any back, neck or brittle bone problems.
- Where possible, please remove your glasses.
- Socks MUST be worn at all times on the inflatable.
- DO NOT climb on the walls between activity sections.
- DO NOT climb on the perimeter walls of the inflatable.
- DO NOT climb over the top of the climbing wall and the slide.
- No running, rough play, tackling, pushing, wrestling etc.
- Food, Drink or Chewing Gum is not allowed on the inflatable.
- DO NOT enter the inflatable park under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Remove all items from your pockets before entering the inflatable.
- Pin badges, belts, buckles, keys, key chains, sharp or pointed items are not allowed on the inflatable.
- We advise you remove all your jewellery before entering the inflatable.
- Disrespectful or abusive language will not be tolerated.
- Please ensure you use the lockers provided for your belongings.
- Only children under 4 years old are allowed in the Toddler Area.
- Enter Ball Pits cautiously, as they may not be as deep as you think.

Please note: it is the responsibility of Parent/Guardian for supervising children under the age of 16. Air Nation is not responsible for the security of your belongings and will not be held liable.

Please adhere to instructions provided by members of the team at all times. You must pay particular attention to the use of the whistle by the staff. This usually indicates foul play which could lead to an injury. This is for your safety and safety of others around you.

We advise all participants to wear long sleeve tops and full length trousers/jeans to avoid minor friction burns; which can occur when playing on inflatables.

In the event that any section of the inflatable deflates, please exit the inflatable immediately and only re-enter when told to do so by a member of staff.

Failure to follow any of these rules can result in serious injury.

CCTV images of all park entrants will be monitored and recorded throughout the premises for the purpose of crime prevention and public safety.

If you flout these rules, you will be ejected from the inflatable park and a refund will NOT be given.
